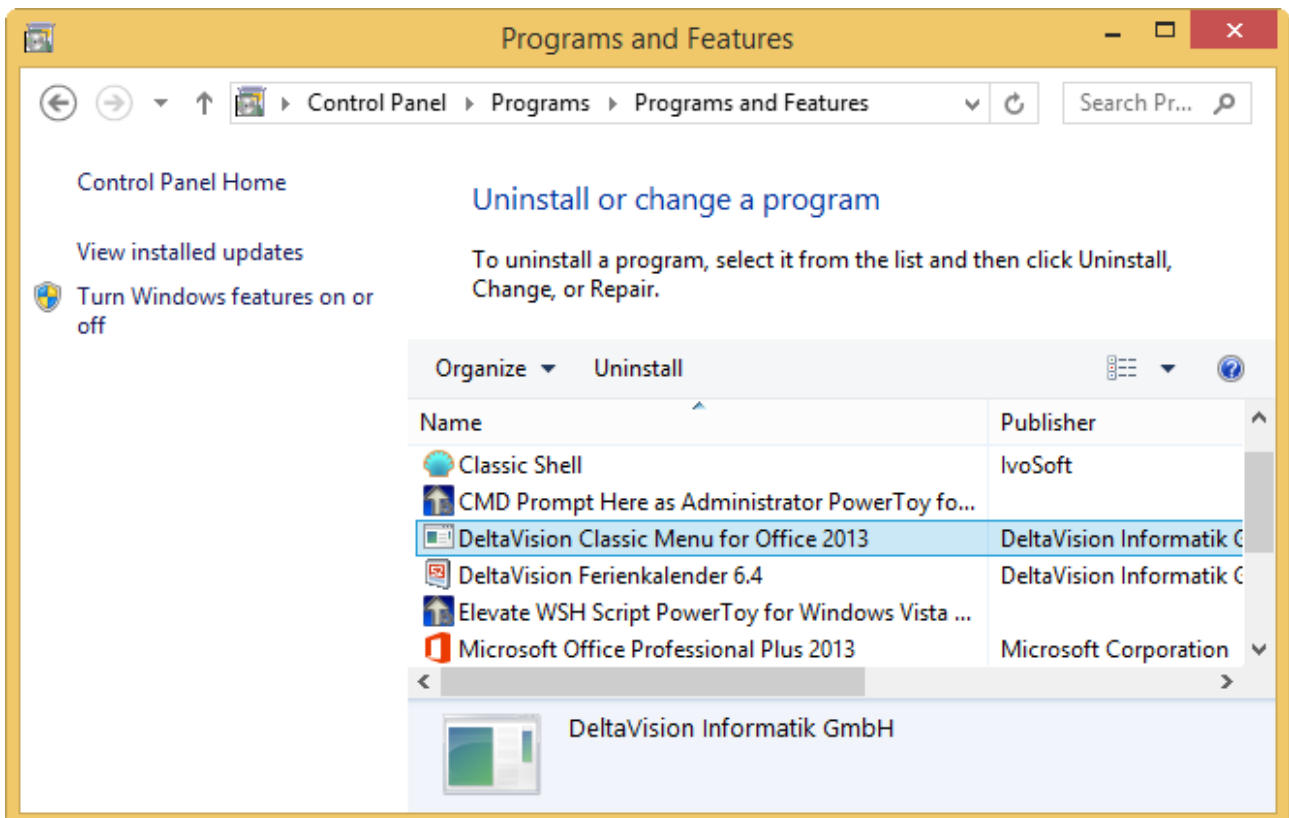


How to uninstall the OfficeClassicMenu

1 Standard Process

The Classic Menu can be uninstalled from your machine like any other application by navigating to **Control Panel > Programs and Features > Uninstall or Change a program**.

Important: Please ensure all instances of Microsoft Office Applications (Word, Excel and PowerPoint) are closed before uninstalling the add-in! Otherwise the program will not be properly removed. In case this happened to you, simply download and install the add-in again and perform the uninstallation process again with all Office applications closed.



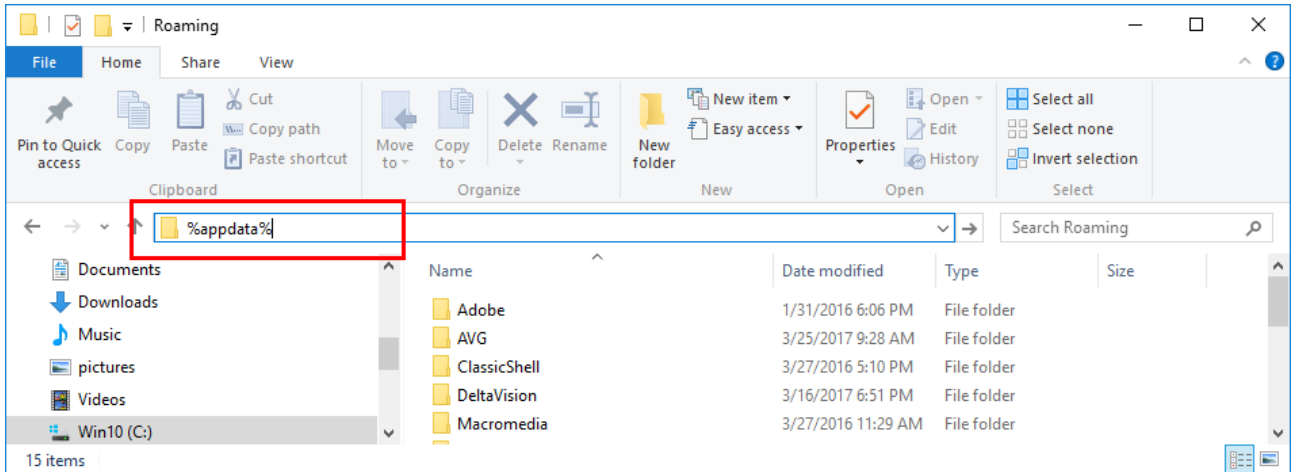
2 Manual uninstall Process

If you have any problems to remove the AddIn, you can also perform this task manually. You only have to delete one file per application.

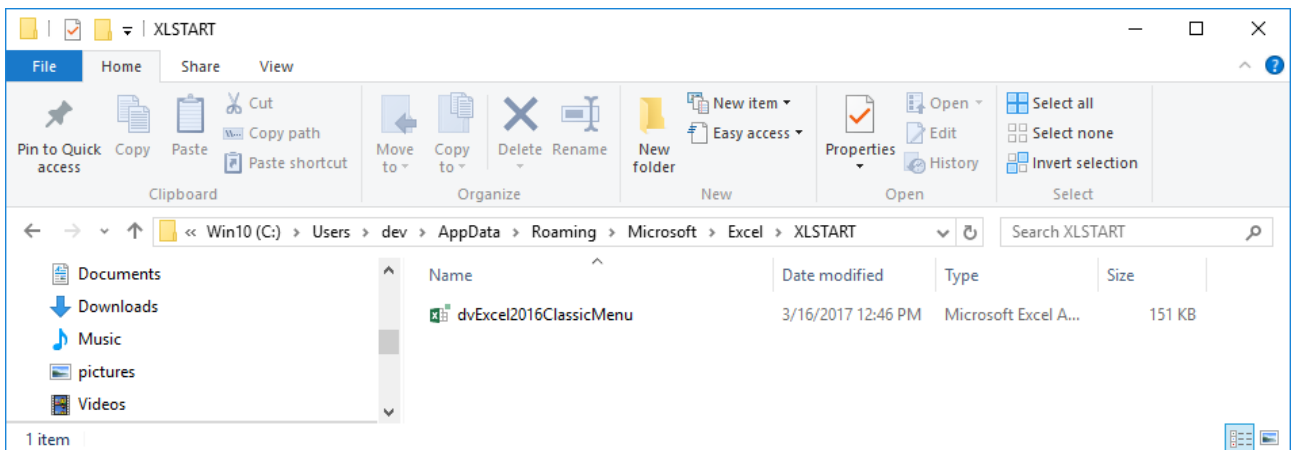
Where the addIn are installed depends on the setup. (User-Setup oder Admin-Setup).

2.1 Uninstall the OfficeClassicMenu (When you installed the user-setup)

- Close Office (Excel, Word, PowerPoint)
- Open Windows Explorer and type `%appdata%` in the address-field. After you have pressed the enter key, windows changes the path like to something like this: `c:\users\YourLogin\AppData\Roaming`



- Then you can navigate to the subfolder **Microsoft**
- The different paths can be found in the table below. Eg. You find the Excel addin under **c:\users\YourLogin\AppData\Roaming\Microsoft\Excel\XLStart**
- The filename depends on the version you installed. eg. dvExcel2016ClassicMenu.xlam



Application	Path to the addin
Excel	%appdata%\Microsoft\Excel\XLStart\ eg. c:\users\[YourLogin]\AppData\Roaming\Microsoft\Excel\XLStart\
PowerPoint	%appdata%\Microsoft\Addins\ eg. c:\users\[YourLogin]\AppData\Roaming\Microsoft\Addins Only in the Spanish -Version from Windows, the last subfolder ist called complementos instead of Addins
Word	%appdata%\Microsoft\Word\Startup\ eg. c:\users\[YourLogin]\AppData\Roaming\Microsoft\Word\Startup\ Only in the Spanish -Version from Windows, the last subfolder ist called Inicio instead of Startup

Table to find the addins

The AddIn filename for the Excel-AddIn is `dvExcel2007ClassicMenu.xlam` or `dvExcel2010ClassicMenu.xlam` or `dvExcel2013ClassicMenu.xlam` or `dvExcel2016ClassicMenu.xlam`

We use the same naming convention for the Word- and PowerPoint-AddIn.

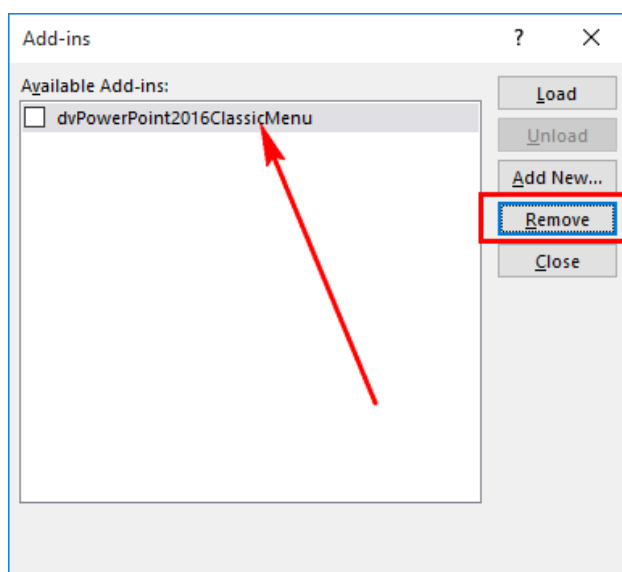
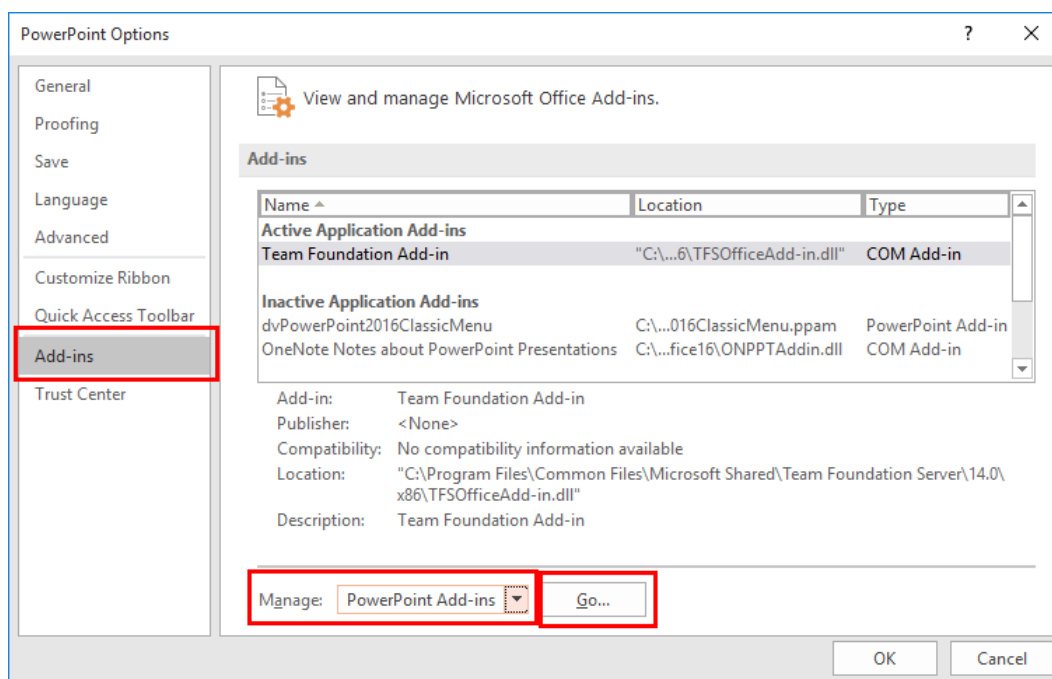
e.g. `dvWord2016ClassicMenu.dotm`

e.g. `dvPowerPoint2016ClassicMenu.ppam`

You only have to delete the addIn. That's all for Word and Excel.

In **PowerPoint**, you have to additionally to remove the addin under the Options.

Goto **File / Options** and Select **Add-ins** on the left. On the right side under **Manage** select **PowerPoint Add-ins** and click to **Go...**

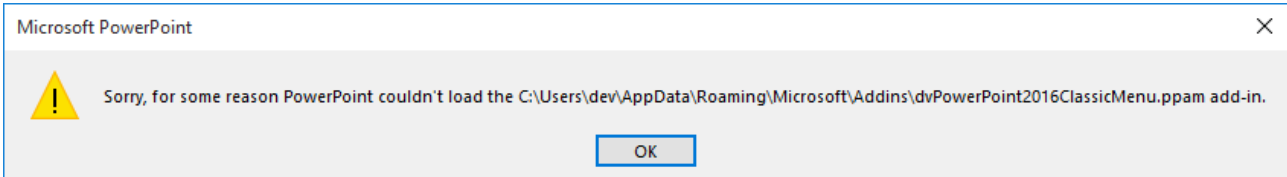


Select the **dvPowerPointXXXXClassicMenu**

Click to **Remove**

Close the dialog.

If you forget to remove the Addin under Options, you get on every start this error-dialog from PowerPoint.



2.2 Uninstall the OfficeClassicMenu (When you installed the admin-setup)

If you installed the OfficeClassicMenu with the admin-setup, you also have to delete only the addins. The addins are located under the program folder.

Application	Path to the addin
Excel	Goto the Root-folder where excel.exe is installed, than navigate to the subfolder xlstart eg. C:\Program Files\Microsoft Office\Office14\XLSTART eg. C:\Program Files\Microsoft Office\Office15\XLSTART eg. C:\Program Files\Microsoft Office\Office16\XLSTART
PowerPoint	Goto the Root-folder where powerpoint.exe is installed, than navigate to the subfolder addin eg. C:\Program Files\Microsoft Office\Office14\Addins
Word	Goto the Root-folder where winword.exe is installed, than navigate to the subfolder Startup eg. C:\Program Files\Microsoft Office\Office14\Startup

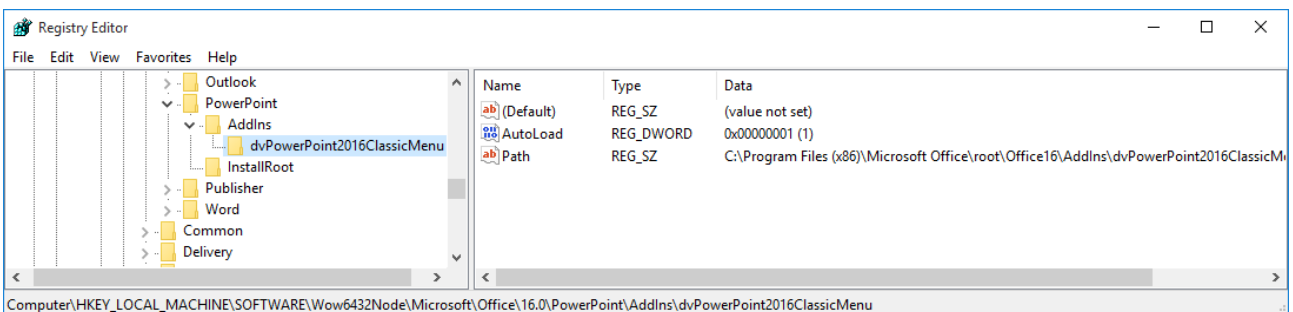
For PowerPoint you also have to delete an Registry key: (You can't remove the addin under options)
Only manipulate the registry if you are familiar with the registry and have made a backup before!

If you have Windows 32 Bit and Office 32 Bit or Windows 64 Bit and Office 64 Bit

HKLM\SOFTWARE\Microsoft\Office\16.0\PowerPoint\AddIns\dvPowerPoint2016ClassicMenu

If you have Windows 64Bit and Office 32Bit

HKLM\SOFTWARE\Wow6432Node\Microsoft\Office\16.0\PowerPoint\AddIns\
dvPowerPoint2016ClassicMenu



You can delete the registry hive with the subkeys *AutoLoad* and *Path*.
The sample is for Office 2016. If you have an other office version, replace the blue settings with you version.
